Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be learning the new routines of the classroom.
We will be learning how to listen to stories.
We will explore how others may be feeling alongside how we are feeling.
We will be learning how to use the different areas within the classroom both inside and outside.

Communication and Language

We will be having conversations with our peers and adults, exploring how to take turns.
We will be exploring a wide range of vocabulary.
We will be exploring 'why' questions and answering in longer sentences.
We will be using: 'and', 'or' and 'because' to join up our sentences when speaking.

We will be using large muscle movements to build up our strength and co-ordination.

Mathematics

They will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison.
We will be exploring positional language.

We will be using our observational skills to notice changes in our environment and have conversations explaining why they are happening.
We will be exploring all the different festivities that happen at this time of year.
We will be exploring keeping ourselves on-line.

Expressive arts and design

We will be developing our observational drawing skills.
We will be exploring junk modelling.
We will be taking part in pretend play, taking turns with our peers.
We will be using small world objects to enhance our story telling experiences.
We will be singing and remembering familiar songs and nursery rhymes.
