Food, glorious food.

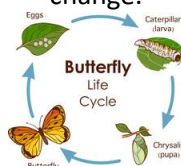
We will be exploring a variety of different foods and where they come from.



Life Cycles

We will be exploring different life cycles. We will be planting our own seeds, caring for them, and watching them grow. We will explore plant life cycles.

We will also have a set of caterpillars to care for in the classroom, observing the different stages of the life cycle of butterflies and how they change.

Literacy

We will continue to practise our segmenting and blending skills in phase 2 and phase 3 phonics, including double letters and longer words.

We will spell words using our phonic knowledge.

We will be using key stories to inspire our writing.

Mathematics

We will continue to explore the composition of numbers to 10 - linking this to familiar patterns, including symmetrical patterns.

We will explore the composition of odd and even numbers, looking at the 'shape' of these numbers.

We will be using our subitising skills to remember number bonds to 10.

Understanding the World

We will be investigating simple maps.

We will investigate where in the world our food comes from.
We will be comparing different environments to the one that we live in.

We will investigate floating and sinking.

We will be exploring transport from the past.

We will be learning about Pancake Day, Easter, Chinese New Year and special places of worship.

We will be learning how to keep ourselves safe online.
