Year 3	<p>J'apprends le français- I am learning French. This topic introduces pupils to French. Pupils will learn where France is and about some French customs.</p> <p>Les salutations- Greetings. In this topic pupils learn to use greetings in French. They learn to say simple phrases such as 'hello', 'My name is', 'How are you?' 'Goodbye'.</p>	<p>Les couleurs et les nombres – Colours and numbers. Pupils will learn to name and recognise ten colours in French. Pupils will learn to count from 1-10 in French.</p> <p>Les animaux- Animals. Pupils will learn to recognise, recall and spell up to ten animals in French. They will be introduced to the phrase 'Je suis'- I am.</p>	<p>L'ancienne histoire de la Grande Bretagne – Ancient Britain. The pupils will learn to know and use correctly the French for 'I am', 'I have' and 'I live'. They will learn to say and spell 'I am a man or woman from the stone age, bronze age and iron age'.</p> <p>Les glaces- Ice-creams. The pupils will learn up to ten ice-cream flavours. They will learn to use the phrase 'Je voudrais'- I would like.</p>
Year 4	<p>Les formes- shapes. Pupils will learn to name up to 10 common shapes in French. They will also recap numbers learnt in Year 3.</p> <p>En classe- In the classroom. Pupils will learn to name familiar classroom objects. They will also learn to use 'J'ai '- (I have) and 'Je n'ai pas de...' (I do not have.)</p>	<p>Les instruments- Musical instruments. The pupils will learn to name up to 10 familiar musical instruments. They will be introduced to the phrase 'Je joue'-I play.</p> <p>Les Romains- The Romans. The pupils will learn about the story of Romulus & Remus. They will learn to name gods and goddesses in French. They will also learn about being a child in Roman times.</p>	<p>Les Saisons- The Seasons. The pupils will learn to name the four seasons. They will talk about their favourite season.</p> <p>Quel Temps Fait-Il? -The Weather In this unit, pupils will learn weather vocabulary. They will work on weather maps and weather forecasts.</p> <p>Les Legumes Les Fruits</p>
Year 5	<p>Je me presente- Presenting myself. In this unit pupils will revise and consolidate their previous learning. Pupils will recall basic French words for numbers, days of the week, months, colours etc. They will group/order unknown vocabulary to help decode text in French. They will improve their listening and reading skills. Pupils will learn to integrate all their new and previous</p>	<p>Les Planètes- The planets. Pupils will learn to name the planets in French. They will be encouraged to listen more attentively and for longer. Pupils will communicate on a wider range of topics and themes. They will understand longer passages in French and start to decode the meaning of unknown words using cognates and context. Pupils will write using familiar French phrases.</p>	<p>La Famille (My Family) In this unit pupils will name family members, use possessive adjectives and talk about siblings. Pupils will also talk about numbers and age.</p> <p>Chez Moi (My Home) Pupils will name different types of home and the rooms in the home. They will also use</p>

	<p>language and learn at least three adjectives in French.</p>	<p>As-Tu Un Animal? (Do You Have A Pet?) In this unit, pupils will name up to eight common pets. They will revisit the phrase 'J'ai'-(I have), and the connective 'et'. In addition to this, pupils will use the phrase 'qui s'appelle'- (that is called).</p>	<p>the phrase "chez moi il y a..." (in my home there is/are...). Pupils will be introduced to the phrase "chez moi il n'y a pas de..." (in my home there is not.../there are no..."). They will attempt to create a longer spoken or written passage in French using the language learnt in this unit and incorporating other language including personal details (such as their name and age etc.). <p>Year 6</p>	<p>In Year six, pupils will: Be able to recall basic French words for numbers, days of the week, months, colours etc. Group/order unknown vocabulary to help decode text in French; Improve their listening and reading skills; Learn to integrate all their new and previous language; Learn at least three adjectives in French. Learn how to report the weather. La Maison Tudor- The Tudors In this unit pupils will learn key facts of Tudor history (examining verbs, adjectives and nouns) They will also learn about Henry VIII and his six wives.</p>	<p>Les Habitats- Habitiats In this topic pupils will learn five basic elements that plants and animals need to thrive and survive in a habitat. They will name five different habitats and examples of each in the world. Pupils will learn which plants grow in each habitat and which animals live in each habitat.</p>	<p>Au Café (At The Café). In this unit, pupils will be introduced to food and drink vocabulary. They will learn to order something to eat and drink in a French café. Pupils will learn typical snacks & drinks you can order in a French café. The pupils will also talk about what they have for breakfast. There are also interactive games based around this new vocabulary plus the breakfast vocabulary learnt in earlier weeks.
