



Music in EYFS

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Children will explore Music through Expressive Arts and Design as well as following our Music Scheme Charanga. Throughout our continuous provision and adult led lessons children will have opportunities to engage in music making with instruments, listen to a range of music from around the world and move to the music they hear. Through our musical units we are able to expose children to ideas and key vocabulary that will support the progression of Music into year 1 and contribute to the children's readiness for the Key Stage 1 Music Programme of study.

To support our readiness we will:

- Play different instruments with increasing control to express our feelings and ideas.
- Access a range of percussion instruments indoors and outdoors and are taught their names.
- Explore how sounds can be changed and learn the related vocabulary e.g., loud/quiet, fast/slow.
- Build up a repertoire of songs and rhymes through opportunities to sing on a regular basis in a group or solo.
- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing our feelings and responses.
- Listen to and watch performances from around the world.
- Begin to play instruments in time to music.
