We will be learning how to manage our behaviours and feelings. We will be discussing what makes a good friend through sharing and caring.

The children receive a 'Wow Owl' when they have achieved a mile stone in their learning or when they are helpful. We will also be sending 'Wow Moments' home for parents to fill in at home.

Communication and Language

We will be listening to and talking about traditional tales and picking up on key phrases and repetitive language. We will continue to learn to listen carefully to our friends and to take turns in conversations during group activities and small group time. After half term we will be talking about the changing seasons as we look for signs of Spring.

Physical Development

We will be continuing to explore different ways of using our bodies to move. We will be using the climbing frame to build up our upper body strength. As part of our daily routine we will continue to do various fine motor activities during Busy Fingers in order to strengthen our finger muscles.


We will continue to do our 'Wake and Shake' exercises and action songs to encourage us to move in different ways.



Learning Experiences Spring 2022 NURSERY

Traditional Tales

We will be reading traditional stories including Goldilocks and the Three bears.



Plants and Growing

We will be learning about plants and what they need to help them to grow.



Literacy

During the first half term we will be taking part in a variety of activities based on traditional tales. After Half term we will be reading stories about plants and growing.

We will continue to explore sounds with Phase One Phonics.

Mathematics

We will continue to learn about counting and numbers through singing a variety of number rhymes and songs and exploring our maths resources. We will be exploring shapes that we use every day in our Nursery environment.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring and talking about different materials and how we can use them to build structures.

After half term we will be learning about what happens in Spring and looking for signs of new life.

Expressive arts and design

We will be exploring mark making with pens, chalks paint and crayons in our creative area. We will continue to encourage the children to be independent in the choices that they make. For example, selecting which tools to use and mixing paint.
