Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we are reopening our nursery later this week.

We have divided Nursery class into two groups to enable the children to return to school and be as safe as is possible. We have divided the class alphabetically. Therefore, your child will be in Sunshine Class, with Miss Peyrovi and Mrs Choudhry.

**On Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June your child can arrive at 8:45 a.m. and be collected at 11:35a.m.** To keep everyone safe I would ask that you arrive promptly, but not too early please. I would also ask that you follow the social distancing measures we are putting in place. For Sunshine Nursery Class, I ask that parents enter the school site through the **IN** car park gate and walk through the green gates towards the nursery. Sunshine Nursery children will enter through the rear doors of the building. Social distancing markers will be placed on the playground to help parents keep 2 metres apart. A member of staff will come out from the building to collect your child at drop off and to bring your child to you at pick up.

I would also ask that where possible only one adult brings your child to school to minimise the number of people on the school site. I realise that some parents will find it difficult if they have other children, but I would urge you to find other provision for them while you drop off and pick up your child. If that is impossible to do, I would ask that other children are kept as close to you as possible and not to be running around the social distancing spaces.

We will not be able to send any books home at the moment, so please do not send in your child's book bag. Please make sure your child has Wellington boots in school and a waterproof coat, as they will be going outside in all weathers.

Could I ask that you ensure your child has a sun hat and sun cream applied before they come to school, and one that will last all day.

We are looking forward to seeing your child again.
